MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

AGE: As mandated by Nebraska Statute 81-1410, an applicant must be at least 21 prior to graduation from the training academy.

DRIVERS LICENSE: Must possess a valid, current drivers license.

EDUCATION: Must have graduated from high school or possess certification of an Education development of at least a high school graduation level (G.E.D). An applicant must also be able to read and comprehend at the 11th-grade level.

HEALTH: An applicant must be able to perform the physical requirements of the position. Mental and physical fitness will be determined by examination.

VISION: An applicant must have corrected vision of not less than 20/30 in both eyes without squinting. There must be no evidence of irreversible disease which will affect the person's sight. Must have acceptable color vision and possess the ability to see peripherally in both eyes.

CITIZENSHIP: Must be a citizen of the United States.
